CRANE SHIPPED FROM ERBIL TO TUNIS BY HEADWAY GLOBAL IN TURKEY

Cargo Connections have welcomed a new Turkey representative; Headway Global, a family based company created and established in Mersin.

Headway Global recently handled shipment of a crane for a large oil company. More than 20 movements were arranged from Erbil up to 5 ports, Karachi, Tunis, Algeria, Jebel Ali and Alexandria port.

Firstly, a lowbed truck was sent to load the crane as it was self-driving. They also arranged to load other equipment into trucks in association with one of their partners in Iraq.

Customs clearance and export formalities had been arranged by their customs brokers at both sides (Ibrahim El Khalil and Habur borders) after getting all the needed approvals and exit documents.

The trucks entered the port of Mersin three days before the vessel's departure avoiding any penalty which may occur and all transit formalities were done by Headway's team at the port.



Finally the crane was loaded successfully directly on Roro vessel to be shipped to Tunis port, and the operation was finished successfully.

- Import handling & customs clearance at Jebel Ali Port
- Coordinate the delivery of the shipment to the client's yard



MULTIPURPOSE & HEAVY-LIFT TRANSPORTATION OUTLOOK FOR PCN: 2Q17

As Project Cargo Network (PCN) members may know, they have secured a special collaboration with Drewry Maritime Research to provide a short presentation periodically.

The latest issue is now available on the Head Office Notices page in the PCN Members Area.

The presentation, for circulation between PCN Members, includes:

- MPV Fleet age profile by vessel type as at June 2017
- Fleet development by vessel type to 2019
- Development of dry cargo demand (million tonnes)
- Development of MPV market share (million tonnes)
- Growth in fleet vs. Growth in demand (%)

According to this latest report, 2017 is expected to show improvement by the end of the year for the multipurpose shipping market and 2018 will see slow recovery over the year with 2019 improving optimism.

Factors affecting the forecast include:

- Global trade growth is improving for the bulk commodities on the back of improving economic growth
- Competing sectors are seeing some upturn in both demand and rates
- Total MPV fleet supply forecast growth at just 0.3%pa but the project carrier segment is much stronger at almost 3%pa over the period

On the downside, project cargo demand lags breakbulk demand and has yet to see significantly positive indicators for medium term growth

EUROPE CARGO WITH SUBMERGIBLE VESSEL PROJECT IN BELGIUM

The semi submergible vessel, MV. Rolldock Sea, carrying a river cruise vessel named 'Rousse' with dimensions of 113 x 16 x 1.7m and a draft of uw. 1,400mtns, sailed from Constanta Port in Romania and arrived at the Abes/ Katoen Natie Terminals (Quay 351) of Antwerp Port under the agency of Europe Cargo in Belgium.

The operation was swiftly completed as follows:

- After arrival, the unlashing of the river cruise vessel commenced at 07.00 and took 4.5hrs.
- The ballasting of MV. Rolldock Sea then started at 15.30 and was completed at 17.30.
- The actual float-off operation in a submerged position began at 17.50 and was completed at 18.12, with MV. Rolldock Sea de-ballasted by 19.30.

Sanne Denessen of the Forwarding Department at Europe Cargo comments: "The river cruise vessel will be used by its owners, Rederij Le Formidable, for party trips from Antwerp Port to Amsterdam Port, including city trips and hotel stayovers. We are very happy to have been a part of this unloading!"

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TURK HEAVY TRANSPORT HANDLE 8 TRANSFORMERS AS PART OF ONGOING PROJECT

Turk Heavy Transport have been continuously involved in an ongoing project of Hyundai Heavy Industries for the Electricity and Water Authority in Bahrain.

They have provided complete port-to-door logistics solutions including barge & road permissions, escort arrangements as well as road-works along the route to make the passage of trucks possible. The cargo consisted of a total of 8 transformers with different capacities, the biggest being 3 x 200tn (400kva).

All of the transformers were received on a 4 file Nicolas hydraulic low-bed at KBS Port in Bahrain before being placed in temporary storage. At a later date, the transformers were reloaded onto a barge (RO/RO) and shipped to a private Jetty where they were offloaded and transported to their final destination. To complete the operations, a total of 4 trips of RO/RO barge were required and the unloading operations at the site were performed using a jack-and-skidding system.

Alpha Maritime Services in Italy are proud to report a successfully handled breakbulk shipment to Mexico.



RACHEL'S CAMPAIGN FOR BETTER INSULIN PUMP SCREENING AT AIRPORTS IS SUCCESS

Rachel Humphrey, Freightbook CEO, started a petition for airports across the world to have a better protocol put in place for people with Type 1 diabetes who are dependent on insulin.

And after months of campaigning, updated guidance material is now being sent to 1,853 airports in 173 countries.

Rachel said: "This is a major achievement for our campaign. I cannot believe how far we have come in just 12 months. I would like to sincerely thank all those who have supported us and helped really make a difference by signing and sharing our petition. I would also like to thank the Airport Operators Association, International Airport Review, UK Civil Aviation Authority, UK Department for Transport, Diabetes UK, Diabetes. co.uk, JDRF and of course Airport Council International World."

Rachel started her campaign after being stopped at Dubai airport last year with her son George, who has Type 1 diabetes. A security guard asked George to remove his insulin pump for an X-ray scan but Rachel argued it was not safe for him to remove it. She said the radiation could pose dangerous interference with the pump's motors. As previously reported in The News, the family were detained at the airport for two hours, which inspired Rachel to start her campaign.

She contacted the Airport Council International who fully supported the campaign by publishing an article 'Best practice for screening of nsulin pumps,' in their world report. More recently Nina Brooks, head of security at ACI World, presented the issue to the International Civil Aviation Organisation, a specialised UN agency and the member states of the Aviation Security Panel, which advise on global standards and oractises. Ms Brooks said: "Updated guidance material will be included in the 10th edition of ICAOs security manual, which is due for release this year."

The guidance material will note that airports should be able to provide alternative screening methods with the same security outcomes and should not require the removal of a medical device. It will also suggest how they should take into account documentation provided from doctors as well as manufacturers discussing the sensitivity of devices to equipment.

Rachel added: "After this success I will be continuing my campaign and petition by working with organisations more. I want insulin pump users to have a stress-free and safe experience at airports."



FAIRPLAY WITH SHIPMENT TO ALGERIA

Due to the out-of-gauge dimensions of the tank, the transport required a low-loader as well as pre-arranged permits and an escort. The challenges encountered during the move included regulations on axle load limits and restrictions on daylight travelling only (06:00 - 18:00) with speed limits of 40-50kmph, enforced by the Kenya National Highway Authority."

"After the safe and well-coordinated trucking from Mombasa Port to the site in Ruaka, we successfully delivered the cargo and we are currently working on similar projects for new plants based on the same model."

CEA THAILAND WITH TRANSPORT & EXPORT OF CATAMARAN FERRY

CEA Project Logistics Thailand were contracted for the transport, storage and export of a catamaran ferry from Chonburi to Freetown in Sierra Leone, West Africa. The catamaran is an ISO Cat. B Offshore Class, weighing 17tn, measuring 17m in length and powered by four Yamaha GETU 250HP engines. When in service, the ferry can carry 80 passengers and crew.

The ferry was moored at the Ocean Marina Yacht Club in Chonburi, Thailand. The CEA teams arrived at the site and supervised the initial lift from the water via a straddle carrier and the

fabricated frame which was attached to a standard low-bed transport trailer.

Due to height restrictions on Thailand's roads, the top section of the ferry was removed and loaded and secured with ratchet straps onto a separate trailer to allow a safe movement along the route to the CEA facility. Once the CEA rigging teams had also secured the main section of the ferry to its trailer, the prime mover left the yacht club to make the 33km journey to CEA Free Trade Zone in Laem Chabang where it was held in storage until the shipping vessel, Atlantic Dawn arrived at port.

After seven days in storage, the ferry was transported to Laem Chabang Port under CEA escort and

CEA WITH ETHOXYLATION PLANT PROJECT
