EUROPE CARGO LOAD MV. ROCHEFORT AT ANTWERP PORT

Europe Cargo in Belgium have recently handled a shipment for one of thei esteemed customers from Antwerp Port to Constanta Port in Romania.

Under the full survey and agency of Europe Cargo, MV. Rochefort was loaded at Antwerp Port with the following cargo:

- 1 x Generator at 124mt
- 1 x Exhaust System Unit at 3.6mt
- 1x Exhaust System Unit at 3.4mt

Sarah Baert of the Forwarding Department at Europe Cargo explains: "The first exhaust system was hoisted and set on the fore of the single hold of MV. Rochefort with the crane geared up with four grommets separated with two spreader bars of 330cm. However, this was too short as two grommets were getting stuck behind protruding parts. Therefore, the spreader bars were lengthened to 360cm, which was enough to lift without problems. Next the generator was safely hoisted and gently stowed in the fore lowerhold. Finally, the second exhaust system was stowed on a tweendeck platform just above the other one.

Both exhaust systems were secured with polyester belts fastened from lifting lugs with rubber protection placed where necessary. The generator was secured only with 14 stoppers – 5 along each side and 2 with uplifting clips at either end."


DC LOGISTICS BRASIL WITH COMPLETE CERAMIC TILE POLISHING MACHINE SHIPMENT

With over 10 years' experience handling special projects in Brazil, DC Logistics have moved a complete ceramic tile polishing machine from Italy to South Brazil.

The shipment consisted of 2 loose pieces each weighing 33.5tns and measuring $16.90 \times 2.40 \times 2.40$, 1×40 ' flat-rack, 10×40 ' OT and 2×20 ' OT. The cargo was picked up at 3 different locations in Northeast Italy and shipped from Leghorn to Navegantes in Brazil. Check out the photos above.

"The main challenge was to load the loose pieces with the containers to a Santa Catarina State Port in Brazil where there is no regular breakbulk service. Due to the length of the loose pieces (16.90m), we were able to ship both pieces loose on a container vessel, loaded and lashed on a bed of flat-racks, along with the containers, all under same Bill of Lading."

FORTUNE LOAD PROJECT CARGO LIKE A GAME OF TETRIS!

Fortune International Transport in Italy have handled 120 project cargo cases with a total volume of 3,000cbm. The handling of the project was entrusted to Fortune by their fellow PCN members in Spain and Portugal, Actanis Project Cargo to coordinate the operations in Italy.

The entire shipment has been delivered to the pier in Bari with special low loaders and heavy powered trucks in the shortest possible period of time - only three days to complete the whole delivery from factory to port. Fortune Managing Director, Paolo Federici explains: "During the last weekend in February, the vessel HR Endeavour, expressively chartered for the movement of this cargo, arrived and was being berthed. On Monday morning, the loading had started and the cases were stored inside the hold of the ship like a big game of Tetris as the photos in the gallery below show. A perfect stowage plan was prepared with the cases loaded on board one-by-one, starting from the heaviest."

"A heavy forklift was placed inside of the hold to move the cases to the most suitable places to occupy all four corners. Two full days were needed to complete the loading and at the end, there was no more space available inside the hold. The last dropping of snow covered the hatches and the vessel sailed with no further delay."

AL NAHRAIN EXECUTES PROJECT IN 3 LOTS FOR MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES IN IRAQ

At the end of 2017, Al Nahrain in Iraq handled a project for the Ministry of Water Resources (MOWR). The cargo was transported from Umm Qasr Port to the MOWR warehouse in Baghdad in three separate lots. For each lot, Al Nahrain's scope of work included port handling, customs clearance and inland transportation.

The first lot, handled in October, consisted of 12 open-top containers loaded with mobile dosing stations plus spare parts, concrete batching plant sections and crew container sections. Each container had a gross weight of 9tns. Director of Operations and Logistics Services at Al Nahrain, Ragheb S. Banat explains: "After receiving the cargo at Umm Qasr Port, we prepared the necessary for a smooth handling. Then, the cargo was stored at a safe and guarded area until the exemption documentation was ready from the MOWR. Once the customs formalities were completed, the

containers were loaded and the trucks departed on the same day headed to Baghdad. Due to the sensitivity of the shipment, on arrival at the MOWR warehouse, we arranged a special mobile crane to safely handle the cargo from the containers with care. All empty containers were then returned back to the carrier's yard at Umm Qasr Port."

The second lot, handled in November consisted of 6 units of silo trailers at a gross weight of 13tns each. Ragheb comments: "The shipment arrived at Umm Qasr Port by RORO vessel and after discharging, the trailers were handled and towed to the storage yard. After customs and documentation formalities, an inspection of the vehicles and the completion of processes from all related departments, we arranged suitable trucks and tractors as the trailers needed to be towed. All trucks reached the final destination in Baghdad and the delivery was completed smoothly and in good order."

roe third lot, handled in December, consisted of 13 units of concrete mixers at 12.8tns each and 3 units of mobile workshops at 7.2tns each. Ragheb S. Banat: "This shipment also arrived at Umm Qasr Port by RORO vessel and being self-propelled, the vehicles were quickly discharged and driven to the storage yard. After customs, documentation and inspection formalities, we arranged the required low-bed trailers which were loaded under the supervision of our expert team who applied the proper lashing and required chains with the whole process controlled with full safety and security as usual. All vehicles departed Umm Qasr Port as one convoy, escorted by our equipped patrols, front and rear, and arrived safe and sound at the final destination in Baghdad."

It was our job to handle the exciting journey of the ice show from Bratislava to Abu Dhabi."

There was a lot of work to do to ensure that all the equipment for the ice show, from the cute bear's masks to the heavy steel structures, arrived on time at the event location in Abu Dhabi. In addition to cargo management, the experienced and reliable ALLSTA team had already assisted with all aspects of planning and customs documentation.

"Four of the higher 40' cube sea freight containers were selected for some of the bulky stage constructions and proper loading was ensured. Afterwards, the containers were to be transported by truck to Vienna railway station and from there by train to the Italian port of Trieste. In order to enable faster customs clearance in the receiving country, four ATA carnets should have been created for the temporary export of the ice show equipment by the Bratislava customs office. However, one container was forgotten by the state railroad at the station and the customs office forgot to list and stamp some parts of the ATA carnet as provided for the customs regulations. The ALLSTA supervisor was on site for the loading in Trieste and was able to clarify everything personally, quickly and flexibly. 


Job Challenges

"Due to the size of the cargo, our first option was to make the transport using 2 contiguous low-beds but we found that the road width was too tight to accommodate this. Our 2nd option was to use modular trailers which proved too expensive for the 12km distance. So, we found a 3rd solution using only 2 extendable low-beds with their length extensions of 25m each to carry 3 units per truck and ensure extra lashing materials and driving with the minimum speed for balance and safety.

"At the Adabiya Port of Loading, the main gates are about 5m wide but our cargo had a width of 7.5m so we had to use the Port's emergency gates and temporarily remove their steel side doors before gating in the trailers using forklifts and labour."

BATI GROUP DELIVERS LARGE FOC REELS FOR TANAP PROJECT

BATI Group has been selected for the prestigious TANAP (Trans Anatolian Natural Gas Pipeline) Project. The objective of the TANAP Project is to move Azerbaijani gas through the Turkish Republic to Southeast Europe in order to procure the natural gas demands of both markets and the construction of the land and sea pipes to be used through the Dardanelles Strait takes place in Biga, Turkey. The total length of the pipeline construction is 1,850km and more than 3 trillion metric cubes of natural gas will be moved through it.

Along with the pipeline construction, a construction of fiber-optic cables (FOC) was also carried out at the end of 2017 in order to enable the acquisition of electronic information at the control points of the pipeline and BATI were tasked to assist. A total of four reels with diameters of 5.5m and widths of 5m (two weighing 95tns and two at 72tns) were used in the operation. Additionally, 2 smaller reels with diameters of 2.7m and widths of 3m (each weighing 2.4tns) were also used.

Mr. Oguz Cankur of the Project Operation department at BATI describes the job: "One of the challenges of this project was the fact that FOC is a unique, sensitive and very expensive product which must be transported with special lashing and care in order to avoid any damage. The FOC's were produced in Norway whilst the reels were produced separately in Rotterdam, the Netherlands.

After loading and lashing was completed, a chartered vessel transported the reels from Rotterdam to Rognan in Norway where they were discharged and transported to the factory for the spooling of the FOC. Afterwards, the spooled reels were loaded onto the same chartered vessel at Rognan and sailed to Icdas Port in Turkey. On arrival, the discharging process promptly commenced with a mobile crane and a high capacity transporter transferred to goods to the stockyard for the shore vessel to lay the FOC reels underwater one by one. The final operation involved the transportation of the empty reels back to Rotterdam.'

The difficult operation was safe and successful for all parties involved thanks to the excellent work from BATI. The photos show the reels during loading.



DC Logistics Brasil have transported 10 jabuticaba trees (Brazilian grape) from Brazil to China by ocean on a 37-day journey as per the requirements of a company specialised in plants.

The trees were moved from Antonina in the Brazilian state of Paraná to Shanghai in China. Leandro Ribinski of the Inside Sales Department at DC Logistics Brasil comments: "When you think of cargo transportation then containers carrying goods like machinery, auto-parts or food may come to mind. Well this shipment may surprise you and make you think differently! This type of operation is not ordinary in Brazil nor in the world."

The trees, which are approximately 6m long each, were carefully laid on flat rack containers. Mr. Ribinski continues: "The trees roots received a chemical treatment and an irrigation device was placed beside them on the container to keep them hydrated and healthy so they arrived in a sound condition at the destination. The operation was only possible due to a special authorization granted by the Brazilian Ministry of Agriculture. I jyestock and Supply."

Managing Director, Mr. Guilherme Mafra points out that transporting these trees: "...was a great opportunity for DC to contribute to the planting of Brazilian fruit trees on Chinese soil. These unique operations reinforce why DC Logistics Brasil has been a highlight in the sector for the last 24 years."

The operation inside the origin port of Paranagua, which is one of the largest container terminals in South America, was carried out in partnership with TCP, the company that manages the container terminal itself. After receiving investments of BRL 365million (one of the largest private incentives in recent years in Brazil), TCP has the capacity to handle 1.5million TEUs a year with 320,000sqm of storage space. Three 879m-long berths are also available as well as exclusive berths for RORO operations.

Esmeralda of the Seas) and ship it off from Valletta harbour to the Caribbean seas. The heavyweight beauty is the result of the fine craftsmanship of Monte Carlo Yachts and she was on her way to her final port of destination in the Everglades, USA.

Prior to commencing the actual operation, we promptly made sure we had all bases covered in terms of permits and paperwork. Our

package for such tasks includes customs clearance and pratique as well as other preparation work such as coordination of the arrival of the vessel and arrangements for berthing. We also line up all required equipment including tugs and stevedores and enlist the right men for the job. For this operation, our team included four welders and six divers

On the day of the operation, the SS4 docked at Valletta. Before we could start floating on the Esmeralda, there were other vessels sitting on board the SS4 that needed unlashing. Once completed, the SS4 began to submerge and take in water and we proceeded to float the Esmeralda on and into its stowing place. It was then the divers turn to intervene and they carefully followed the Esmeralda, setting up stands and lashing in preparation for the de-floating before making way for the welders. However, the welders did not have it easy at all as heavy rain started which added an extra layer of difficulty to their task at hand but they got the job done without a hitch and the SS4, loaded with the Esmeralda and other yachts, was good to sail off. A Closer Look at the Super Servant 4

For those who aren't familiar with the vessel, the Super Servant 4 was



designed in 1982 and is a semi-submersible heavy load carrier that makes use of a complex ballasting system which allows it to sink partially, load or unload heavy floatable cargo, and re-emerge, before sailing off for long-range navigation. The loading and unloading is known in the industry as floating in/on and floating off respectively.

usually carries ranges from oil rig equipment to smaller vessels like yachts. When carrying yachts, it bounces back and forth along the transatlantic route between the Mediterranean to the United States and Caribbean during different yachting seasons, allowing patrons to enjoy some good-weather seafaring. It is necessary as such yachts are not customarily equipped to handle such long navigational routes which would heavily burden their engines with unfittingly long operational hours. Other factors taken into consideration also include fuel and crew expenses and insurance as well as heightened storm and accident risk factors.

The Super Servant 4 has only recently been serviced, refitted, and given a full tune-up to ensure it was in top-notch shape and in keeping with industry standards."




