

CROWN LOGISTICS DELIVER BULK SHIPMENT TO LAOS

In September, Crown Logistics (members in Vietnam) successfully managed the transit customs clearance and transportation of fuel silo parts and their accessories. The bulk cargo was shipped from Shanghai in China to Hai Phong Port in Vietnam with the final destination in the Xepon District in Savannakhet, Laos.

The cargo travelled a distance of 798km from Hai Phong Port to the factory site in Laos using low-bed chassis trucks with the total volume of the shipment measured at nearly 500cbm.

Peter Linh (Managing Director) explains: "We had a good period of consultancy with our client to understand the difficulties of the transportation schedule from Hai Phong Port to Laos through the inland Lao Bao / Savannakhet borders. It took 2 nights of transportation to reach the border and arrange transit customs before the trucks could pass through into Laos."

"During the transportation, we ran into problems with heavy rain and wind which impeded operations. However, our drivers are well-experienced in moving cargo to Laos and even though some areas were flooded along the way with dangerous winds and deep water on the road which strongly affected our delivery and unloading plans, our professional operations team smoothly and safely solved the problems."

Crown Logistics finally delivered the cargo to the open yard site smoothly and successfully and within 3 days with safety as the highest priority and zero issues.

NEW WORLD LOGISTICS WITH AIR TRANSPORT OF ROTOR SHAFT

New World Logistics are pleased to share a project involving the round-trip air shipment of a rotor shaft for a steam turbine sent from Vietnam to Japan for repair. The multi-transportation project saw the unit transported from the client's site in Vietnam to Hanoi, flown to Japan by Boeing 747-8F aircraft, delivered to Okayama for repair and then the reverse journey back.

The rotor shaft had dimensions of 4.5 x 2.3 x 2.1m and weighed 6,800kg. The scope of work handled by New World Logistics included:




UNI-HOME HANDLE BREAKBULK SHIPPING OF ANNEALING FURNACE

- Delivery to loading jetty at Tsurumi, Japan
- Loading cargo onto heavy lift vessel
- Shipping to Singapore

"Due to the sensitive cargo and it's weight and dimensions, the transport, loading and storage required long and careful pre-planning. We also applied for the road permits 3 months in advance as in Japan, it's extremely difficult to get transport permits for inland transportation due to tight spaces and extremely severe regulations. Furthermore, it was also quite a challenge to obtain the temporary storage at the port due to very limited space."

"Our experienced team in Tokyo lead by Mr Kazuhiro Furukawa and Mrs Reina Kanai carefully planned and carried out all necessary steps to get permits and book SPMTs and vessel space so that project was carried out ahead of time and very smoothly."




O&S SHIPPING HANDLE TRANSPORT OF 500TN SUPER YACHT



Members in Malta, O&S Shipping are proud to share details of a project to handle the transport of a 500tn super yacht.

The 95m yacht (53rd longest in the world) needed to be transported quickly from Malta to Cartagena in Spain and O&S successfully organised the vessel, port agency, logistics and all coordination for the project. Please visit the online story for more photos.

Managing Director at O&S, Kurt Camilleri explains: "The entire operation had to be planned in one week and in this case, the yacht couldn't sail on its own power at all so after considering several options, we used the services of the impressive yacht-carrying vessel, the Super Servant 4, a semi-submersible vessel dedicated to yacht relocation around the world."



After careful planning, the yacht was loaded and secured into position on the Super Servant 4 and was ready for transportation. Kurt: "The mission was further complicated by strong winds and usually a yacht-transfer of this size would be carried out at an assigned anchorage area, however the wind did not permit such an operation. Due to these circumstances, we had to convince the authorities to allow the operation within Valletta Port with a thorough risk assessment. Another issue was the sea depth in the port and we had to ensure we picked a deeper spot within the port for the operations."
