The cargo consisted of 233 pieces of equipment and breakbulk cargo, at a total weight of 8,500frt, and was loaded in 4 different locations; Kutum, Malha, Mellit and El Fasher to be transported to Port Sudan for export to South Africa.

HACKLIN WITH HUGE REACTOR SHIPMENT

Hacklin Logistics are currently handling the shipping of a huge reactor from Shanghai in China to South Eastern Finland.

The shipment is being handled port-to-door and the reactor measures 29.52 x 3.94 x 4.15m and weighs 50.5ths

The cargo was loaded in Shanghai onto CMA CGM Benjamin Franklin and Mrs. Virve Hyytiäinen (Sales Manager at Hacklin) comments that the size was a new record loaded at the Yanghan Terminal. The reactor will be trans-loaded in Hamburg before delivery to South Fastern Finland

The latest project handled by Westlink Logistics in Australia involved ammonia flow control units (AFCUs) transported to several locations in the USA for various power industry projects.

Westlink's scope of work included project management, operational supervision & coordination, ocean freight, cranage, transportation to site, customs and quarantine clearance.

The multimodal (air, sea & road) transportation was safely and successfully completed due to Westlink expertise and continuous

CEA WITH DEMOBILISATION & EXPORT PROJECT

CEA Project Logistics in Thailand have recently carried out the demobilisation and export to Malaysia of a 150th high-pressure plastic injection moulding machine. The original factory installation of the machine was undertaken by Mitsubishi technicians who were also on hand for

The CEA team began with disconnecting all hydraulic and electrical connections and other wired interfaces. Gates and fencing were then removed along with the hydraulic power packs which were placed into prefabricated temporary supports. The larger parts were next, which included access platforms, supply hopper and the SEPRO robotic arm. Marketing & Communications Manager at CEA, Earl C. Brown explains: "The SEPRO robotic arm is used for the unloading from the machine and some technical and expert rigging was used to ensure it was fully balanced while being dismantled from the main unit. The SEPRO arm was then lowered to the floor and supported whilst our expert team further proceeded to dismantle it into its respective structural movement axis".

The injector unit was removed next and immediately transported to the CEA facility in Laem Chabang for careful packing and the loadout. The heaviest components were the last to be removed including the

46th die head and the rear platen with ejector unit at 42ths. Earl continues: "The CEA project teams removed the tie bar cap plates after first draining the residual oil, and then, using cranes, proceeded to slide out the four 6th tie-rods that connect the tie head and platen. Each of these were immediately loaded onto wooden supports and treated for rust protection".

Using a special jig and tools, specifically produced for this demobilisation, the teams lifted both the die head and then the platen by means of top and tailing cranes (120tn and 50tn). Both the die head and platen were moved into a horizontal position and loaded directly onto low bed trailers before being transported to the CEA facility. Upon arrival at the CEA facility, all parts were thoroughly cleaned and prepared for export with the larger parts shrink-wrapped and loaded onto flat racks and other auxiliary parts packed and stuffed into standard 40ft shipping containers. The SEPRO robotic arm was lifted into an open top container and secured in place with ratchet straps and wooden chocks. CEA Project Logistics also completed all necessary documentation in preparation for the export to Malaysia.

The whole project was completed in seven days - Another successful operation handled by CEA!

CEA CONTRACTED FOR TRANSPORTATION & INSTALLATION OF STORAGE TANKS

CEA Project Logistics Myanmar were recently contracted to handle the transportation and installation of two 18th vertical storage tanks at a Yangon brewery. The project proved complex due to two cranes being required to operate in a very narrow location outside the facility.

In advance of the installation project, CEA Engineering submitted highly detailed lift plans for approval by the client and before the arrival of the tanks, the CEA team prepared the installation area and affixed anchor bolts to each concrete tank base. After the first tank had arrived, a 100th mobile crane and a 30th tailing crane positioned themselves either side of the trailer in the narrow alley. The required slings were attached to both ends of the tank and the cranes managed the tight lift successfully and safely.

Due to working in such a confined space, each tank had to be lifted above and clear of the adjacent buildings and the crane then turned and lowered each tank onto its concrete base allowing for the final alignment and the anchor bolts to be fixed.

After assembly, the helicopters will fly to their new base in Northern Thailand to replace the Bell UH-1H helicopter.

Earl Brown (Marketing & Communications Manager) explains: "The helicopters arrived at Laem Chabang Port A-5 on the NYK vessel, Oceanus Leader. Each helicopter was shipped on a MAFI trailer with a bespoke fabricated saddle for the rear landing gear. Laem Chabang Terminal Tractors removed the helicopters from the vessel, positioning them next to CEA's 50tn mobile cranes. Each helicopter was then lifted from the trailers by a specialised hook attached to the main rotor (the five shackles of the hook were fixed to the main rotor by five lifting slings) and lowered on to awaiting Air Ride trailers also each fitted with a saddle for the rear landing gear.



Wooden chocks were placed on the front landing gear and lashing was safely applied. CEA further secured the cargo with more two more lashing slings connected to the rings on either side of the fuselages. After the other aircraft accessories were loaded and each helicopter was lashed and secured, the convoy began the 70km journey to the Royal Thai Navy base at Utapao in Rayong Province with a CEA escort vehicle used throughout the specialised transport to ensure maximum safety on the route.

Upon arrival at Utapao, the CEA teams removed the lashing, allowing the 50th mobile cranes to lift the helicopters from the trailers using the same method as before and placing them in their respective hangers. The project was swiftly handled with a duration of just 7 hours from start to finish."

Before any of the Komatsu's left the storage area, each one underwent an inspection and test drive around the yard to ensure that every system of the truck was functioning correctly after a year in storage. After all checks were completed and all parties were satisfied, the trucks made the short journey across the port one by one. Each truck was shadowed by two CEA escort vehicles per trip to ensure maximum safety for all other years on the route.

Upon arrival at the C-O Terminal, each truck was positioned alongside the Singaporean-flagged vessel, AAL Dampier. The Dampier's stevedoring team quickly got to work securing the necessary rigging equipment for the lifting and to maintain efficiency throughout the project, as each Komatsu began its lift onto the vessel, the next one would begin the journey from the CEA Free Trade Zone. This efficiency resulted in all 13 Komatsu Trucks onboard, secured and ready for shipping in less than two days which was one day earlier than had been initially projected, much to the delight of the client.

SUCCESSFUL DELIVERY OF BREAKBULK CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS BY RDL LOGISTICS

RDL Logistics in Cambodia have finalised the delivery of 14,638.66mt of breakbulk cargo for the construction of a leading hotel, casino and entertainment complex in Phnom Penh. The shipment, consisting of construction materials (steel bars and plates), was safely shipped on a chartered vessel from Tianjin in China to Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam and then transported to Cambodia.

One of the biggest challenges during the operation was the transport of the oversized items in a safe and economical way. Sales & Marketing Manager at RDL Logistics, Mr. Nuon Ratana comments: "We were involved in this project since the feasibility research had been launched in early 2015. RDL surveyed the barges' various capacities and routing obstacles to assist the shipper in determining the packing style and dimensions necessary. We also pre-studied this case with the concerned partners including the Authorities of the Phnom Penh New Container Terminal in order to obtain their special approval to receive the large amount of breakbulk cargo at their terminal.

Then, the coordination between RDL, the relevant partners and Kampuchea Shipping Agency & Brokers (KAMSAB - the Cambodian

official authority for the immigration of vessels & barges) was put into motion to get the entrance permit and carry out the river border operation for six barges as well as piloting to NCT via the Mekong River.

The RDL team then performed the local handling services including delivery in coordination with the Ministry of Interior to arrange police escorts for the oversized items trucking along the busy National Road #1 from the NCT to the jobsite. The full operations were completed in 10 months, port-to-door."

RDL will continue to handle work for the project until the end of 2018.







OLA HANDLE OVERSIZED TRANSPORT OF TRUCK CRANES

OLA Logistics have recently arranged the oversized transportation of 2 sets of truck cranes. Each set had a gross weight of 32,000kgs and dimensions of 13.00 x 2.55 x 3.50m.

Director, William Wan explains: "As truck cranes are self-propelled cargo, we would usually use a RORO service. However, the RORO service only runs one vessel per month from the required port (Nansha) and the customer was eager to receive the cranes. Therefore, we suggested that we use 40'FRs to handle the cargo, providing more vessel schedule choice, a shorter transit time and a cheaper ocean rate. Nansha Port is not well equipped for loading and unloading oversized cargo in the container yard which posed another challenge but the professional OLA team safely and successfully handled the operations".

The loading and clearance process of the high-value cargo had to be very carefully handled due to the adverse weather conditions of Storm Sandy but the expertise of Sham Logistics Services lead to a successful operation 48 hours earlier than their commitment to the customer.

AT JSL GLOBAL IN QATAR

Three recent projects handled by JSL are outlined below

NEW PORT PROJECT (NPP)

JSL Global completed the offloading, local transportation and handling of 40 modules arriving at Hamad Port from Croatia. Each module weighed 25mt with dimensions of 14.0 x 3.6 x 3.6m. When the vessel berthed at Hamad Port, JSL noticed that the cargo was very delicate and because of its hollow structure, the chances of damage were high if loaded on a low-bed trailer which was less than the cargo's width. Therefore, JSL were challenged to obtain trailers longer (14m) and wider (3.6m) than the modules. Jigar Shah comments; "This was difficult as most of the trailers which are this long have a ramp at the end and do not equal 14m straight and of the few trailers which were available at the long length, they did not match the required width. Also, the Hamad Port gate has a width criteria and if we used a trailer of 4m wide, we would have to enter and exit using a special gate which requires permission from customs & Qatar security etc. which would be even more time consuming". JSL Global managed to mobilise the required trailers within very short notice, all at 14m long with a mix of 3.6m and 4m wide. They also managed to handle the full job within the minimum port storage time. An impressive achievement! Jigar Shah concludes; "Project logistics is always a mix of challenges and there is rarely a straight forward solution to specific problems. JSL's professional logistics experts minimise the problems and work out a win-win, competitive solution for all parties. Our 'go-getter' attitude has always helped to overcome such challenges and these experiences extend our track record to confidentially and successfully accomplish future projects".

QATAR SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

JSL Global handled a tunnel boring machine from Antwerp (Belgium) to Hamad Port in Qatar. The job consisted of 44 pieces at 729mt / 2,860cbm by RORO vessel with individual pieces up to 5.3m wide and weighing 55-80mt. JSL handled the cargo when Hamad Port had recently started operations with only RORO vessels calling at the new port and all operations for containerised and breakbulk vessels were handled at Doha Port. Also, as Hamad Port was new, there were no cranes to handle the heavy pieces of 80mt so JSL held preliminary meetings with the Hamad Port Operation Officials to obtain special permission to mobilise an external 200mt crane to complete the operations.

During the preliminary route surveys from Hamad Port to the client's site, JSL found an additional challenge to transport the OOG cargo using new roads and bridges due to the ongoing construction in Qatar for FIFA 2022. JSL also arranged all permissions, documentation, customs clearance, planning and all follow-up and coordination.

QATARI IDRIS MEGA PROJECT

JSL handled another tunnel boring machine & backup system weighing a total of 640mt / 2,300cbm from Huangpu in China to Hamad Port, Qatar. The cargo was handled in 2 breakbulk shipments, each with 21 pieces. JSL transported the cargo using 38 low-bed and long trailers from Hamad Port to the client's site where they were offloaded using cranes. They took direct delivery of all the heavy and OOG pieces on their trailers as well as arranging police escorts due to measurements of individual pieces at over 3.6m wide and 4m high and weighing over 40mt.

The main challenges for this project included the customs procedures as the cargo was made in Germany with the shipment coming from China. Mr. Jigar Shah explains: "As per Qatar customs, all commercial documents from the shipping country are required and we had several brainstorming sessions with Qatar custom officials who recommended suitable options to the client. Another issue with such high value temporary importation into Qatar is a lot of paper work, permits and approvals required when the consignee is a joint venture company. It was a challenge to get certain documents signed and stamped in the short time but the JSL team, with support from the client & Qatar customs, managed to get the approval on time. In 2016, Hamad Port Authorities were allowing 3 calendar days for free storage and after that, they levied heavy storage tariffs. Such projects as this would usually get delayed in custom clearance because of the temporary import permits, approvals and the physical inspection of every part including checking serial numbers etc. However, the professional JSL team is well experienced in handling project cargo and liaising with government officials and we managed this temporary import custom clearance within 2 days of the vessels arrival and delivered it to the client as per the given deadline."
